## **ORDER**

Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion to Modify the Stay Entered on May 17, 2016 [Dkt. No. 2137], Defendants' Opposition [Dkt. No. 2145], Plaintiffs' Reply [Dkt. No. 2147], and the entire record herein, it is this 12th day of July, 2016, hereby

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' Motion is granted in part and denied in part; and it is further ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' request to have the Defendants report to the Court on the 15th of each month regarding their performance in the prior month is denied; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' request that Defendants provide provisional Medicaid eligibility to any (non-disability) Medicaid applicant who identifies him or herself to the District of Columbia with a good-faith claim that he or she has applied for Medicaid and that his or her application has not been acted upon within 45 days is **granted**. The provisional Medicaid eligibility shall end when Defendants make a determination on the application and provide the applicant with written notice of the decision in accordance with applicable Medicaid regulations; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' request to provide 90 days of continued Medicaid eligibility to any Medicaid beneficiary who identifies him or herself to the District of Columbia with a good-faith claim that he or she has been or is soon to be terminated from Medicaid at renewal/recertification without advance written notice or that he or she has submitted the renewal/recertification form or required documents, but has been or is soon to be terminated from Medicaid on the grounds that he or she failed to submit the form or required documents is **granted**. The period of continued Medicaid eligibility shall end when Defendants make a determination on the renewal/recertification and provide the applicant with written notice of the decision in accordance with applicable Medicaid regulations; and it is further

**NOTED**, that a brief Memorandum Opinion shall be filed within the next several weeks.
